

The Linux Users' Group of Davis presents:

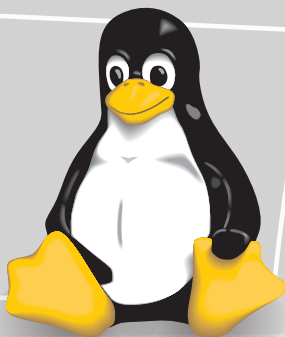


The Digital Tipping Point

... is a documentary film project about the big changes that **open source software** (such as the Linux operating system and Firefox web browser) will bring to our world. Like the printing press before it, open source software will **empower** average people to create an immense wave of new literature, art, and science.

Christian Einfeldt is a simple end user who proves daily that any knucklehead can use open source. Motivated to move his law practice to open source in late 2000 out of a concern for viruses, he saw that it represents **a chance for humanity** to practice sharing on a massive scale. He became convinced that he had to do his part to use video and the Internet to give the world some footage to fuel the conversation about what **cyber freedom** means and why it is important. The Digital Tipping Point resulted.

Christian will tell the odd story of how it got started, about the places that they have been, what they have accomplished so far, and what they need to finish the project.
