SugarCRM's functionality includes sales-force automation, marketing campaigns, customer support, collaboration, mobile CRM, social CRM and reporting. Created as an open source project in April 2004, and founded as a company in June of the same year, SugarCRM is currently headquartered in Cupertino, California. It was named one of the 10 most successful open source projects in 2012 by Network World Magazine.
