

Go is a new programming language created in 2006 by Google. It's released as open source software for Linux, Mac Os X, Windows and more. While originally envisioned as a modern alternative to static languages such as C++ and Java, it has found a steady following in refugees from dynamic languages such as Ruby and Python due to its simple, consistent, and performant design.
